Science Café is a place where, for the price of a cup of coffee or a pint of beer, you can learn about the latest ideas and issues in science and technology in an informal setting.

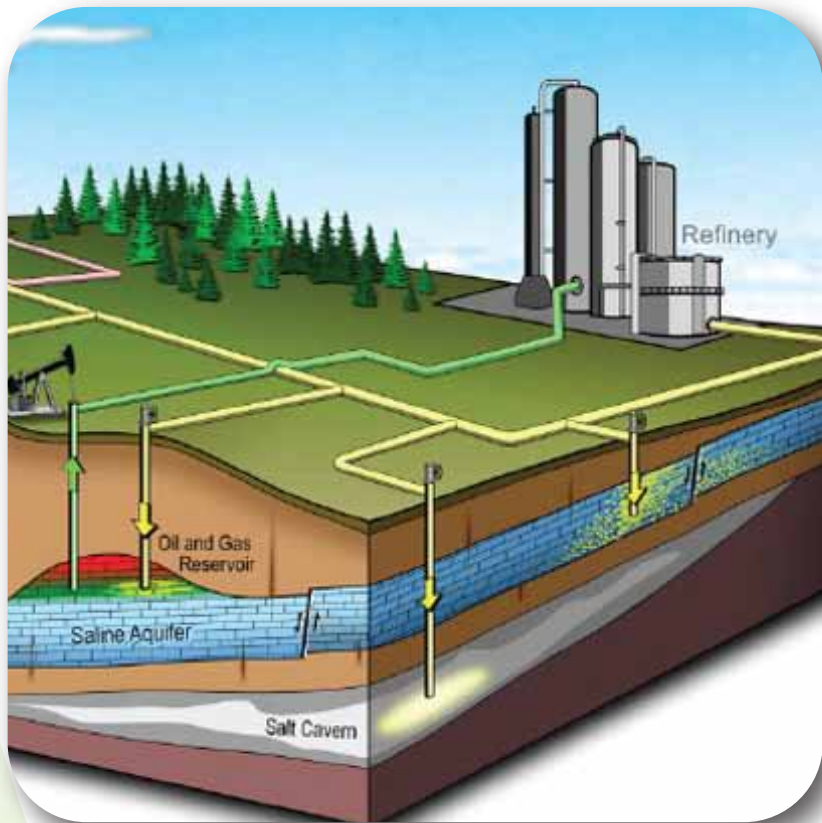
